Oeiras bets on Air Electric Mobility

The municipality of Oeiras and the [Megellan 500](#) consortium signed a protocol to implement an Air Electric Mobility project in the metropolis. This project is intended for passenger transport and involves the installation of vertiports for aircraft bases and VTOL-electric vehicles with vertical take-off. It is estimated that the system will be in operation within six years.

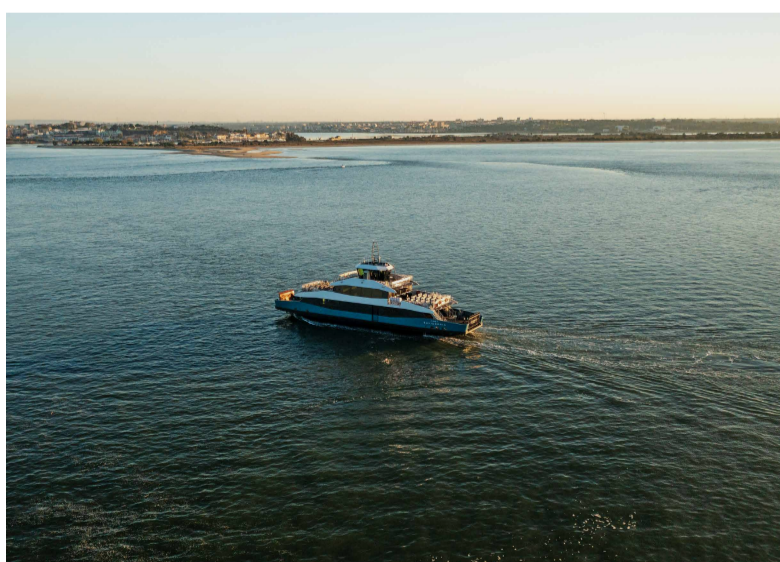

Albergaria-a-Velha encourages the use of bicycles in the municipality

In [Albergaria-a-Velha](#), in the district of Aveiro, the MOB.A - Mobilidade Operação Bicicleta project was implemented, which provides bicycles for free public use. The programme has three main objectives: to foster a culture of sustainable travel in the city, reduce the use of motorised vehicles, and encourage an active and healthy lifestyle.

Aveiro has the Iberian Peninsula's first electric ferryboat

"Salicórnica" is the first electric ferry developed entirely in Portugal by Portuguese companies to serve a Portuguese region. It is also the first electric ferry on the Iberian Peninsula. The vessel, which links São Jacinto to Forte da Barra (Aveiro), has zero CO2 emissions, eliminating more than 300 tonnes of CO2 released by the previous model in operation and reducing energy consumption by around 30%.
